

Guidance for applying for the Coronavirus EIDLs online

It appears that many business applicants are not checking the correct option when applying for the EIDL. Please advise your customers and constituents that they **MUST** select the Economic Injury (EIDL) Loan Option as shown below, in order to proceed with applying for the EIDLs for the Coronavirus situation. If they select the wrong option, they do not have to re-register but they will need to start the application again.
